boat which saves soldiers from Dunkirk
in p. 1. be a tribute to British efficiency of a defeatist
boat-building & boat-handling is not just a defeatist
tribute to the accuracy of German dive-bombing. Why should
not the boat have survived one bomb after another?
Far more than were lost. We should make the most
of that point.
